Mr. Chappell moved to approve the purchase of 9 rain suits for the Public Works Department for a total cost of \$747.00 from Cinderz Embroidery & Silk Screening. Ms. Craig seconded. 3 Ayes. Motion carried.

\* REQUEST FROM WEST ALLEGHENY FOOD PANTRY to the Township and Waste Management requesting consideration for a dumpster at their new location. Ms. Craig will contact Waste Management.
