### Projects Taking Place at the Landfill

As part of Imperial Landfill's strong community commitment, during Fall 2010 we completed installation of a geo-membrane liner on just over 42 acres. The liner consists of a geo-membrane rain tarp that covers a portion of the landfill where odor was occurring. The green colored liner prevents odor from escaping the landfill. With this year's completed work, it brings a total of 91 acres that is covered by a liner.

Additionally, Imperial Landfill enhanced its gas, storm water, and leachate collection system. Future plans call for moving waste disposal operations farther away from Wilson School and additional ongoing improvements to our gas, storm water, and leachate collection systems.
